1. Abide by the UK Ultimate Member Code of Conduct
2. Exhibit good character and conduct myself as a positive role model
3. Have full knowledge of, and abide by, the rules of Ultimate and maintain current WFDF rules accreditation (ideally to Advanced level)
4. Maintain good communication with the GB Programme and designated team managers and respond promptly to requests for information
5. Adhere to financial and paperwork deadlines as set and communicated by the GB Programme and designated team managers
6. Disclose pre-existing or new medical conditions that may impact upon my safety, performance or participation in the GB Programme to the team coach/manager
7. Adhere to GB kit requirements as set the GB Programme and designated team managers
8. Follow conditions set out by sponsors of the GB Programme or your team
9. Abide by the rules and regulations governing the use of training and competition facilities and equipment
10. Abide by the UK Ultimate Anti-Doping policy and rules, in addition to complying with the requirements of the WADA code
11. Abide by the GB Ultimate Social Media Policy
12. Abide by team-specific "Team Agreement" or requirements as detailed by designated team managers
13. Work on agreed performance targets as set by my designated coach, team manager or related support staff
14. Comply with reasonable requests to attend certain promotional events and 'athlete appearances' in support of the GB Programme and/or it's sponsors

The text of the Code of Conduct from that document is as follows:

Members of UK Ultimate are expected to behave in a manner that is consistent with the ideals of the organisation with specific consideration to the following points:

- **Spirit of the Game:** members are expected to support and protect the Spirit of the Game.
- **Respect:** members are expected to be respectful in dealing with their team-mates, opponents, staff, volunteers and spectators both on and off the field.
- **Safety:** members are expected to conduct themselves in a safe and orderly manner – both on and off the field.
- **Rules:** members must adhere to the WFDF Rules of Ultimate and/or any variations that are in place for a specific UKU-sanctioned event.
- **UKU Policies:** members should be aware of and adhere to all other UKU policies (e.g. Equity Policy) and Competition Rules (e.g. relating to player eligibility and anti-doping).
